Acceptable Outer Wear Styles

Can be worn inside the school building any solid color.



EISD letter jackets and school organization sweaters or jackets are acceptable.

Acceptable Socks/Hosiery/Leggings

Socks (ankle, mid-calf and knee) hosiery, leggings and tights. When hosiery, leggings and tights are part of the attire they must be worn under skirts or dresses.

School Shirts: Must be either a polo or oxford dress shirt in the school color or have the school logo and be a campus approved to be worn daily.



Logos: Restricted to manufacturer's Professional embroidered logos Approximately the size of a student ID card/credit card (approximately 2 inches by 3 inches or less)

Must be one solid color of black, brown, navy or white.


Acceptable Styles of Hair

Hair styles must appear neat and clean. Subtle shades of natural or ethnically acceptable hair colors and/or highlights.



Unacceptable Colors of Hair

Unnatural hair colors including primary colors, intermediate colors and /or metallic colors. Combs or picks worn in the hair.



Acceptable Head Coverings

None, except for special occasions approved by the principal. Exemptions and opt-out provisions will be considered for religious or medical reasons.

Unacceptable Head Coverings

Head coverings are not permitted and cannot be visible on campus, in the school building, or in the waiting areas on campus. Head coverings include, but are not limited to sweatbands, caps, hats, bandanas, skull caps and hoodies.



Tops and Bottoms

Approved Colors for Bottoms

Jumpers/Skirts/Skorts/Pants/Shorts/Capris



Black Navy Khaki Any shade of the color Khaki

Acceptable Styles of Bottoms

Pleated or flat front style, cotton, twill, chino .etc. most fabrics other than denim.

Length:

Grades PK-4: hem of the pants/shorts/capris must not be more than 3 inches above the knee.

Grades 5-12: hem of the pants/shorts/capris must touch the kneecap or below.



Unacceptable Styles of Bottoms

Jumpers/Skirts/Skorts/Pants/Shorts/Capris

(Jeggings, jeans or denim material of any color)

Acceptable Footwear

Any style or color of tennis shoes is acceptable grey brown, black or white leather-like shoes or boots.

Other Items

Acceptable: Ties: neck ties are authorized only for school designated events. Girl's accessories such as bows, barrettes, head bands, etc. are not required to follow the approved standardized dress code. Students will only be allowed to wear clothing outside of the standardized dress code during Incentive Days as designated by the campus principal as a reward and motivation for the students. Incentive Days will be available as a campus reward for various reasons; attire and date will be determined at the discretion of the campus principal (e.g. career day, college day, picture day, spirit day etc.)

Unacceptable: Sunglasses and extreme styles of contact lenses during school hours. No jeans at all chains such as those connected to clothing, wallets etc. large medallions, teeth grills, articles with spikes including but not limited to, dog collars. Visible body piercing except for the ears. Visible excessive tattoos that distract or take away from the academic climate. Excessive earrings and excessive gauging, holes in the ears. No designs are allowed in eyebrows. No scarfs, jewelry referring to alcohol and other drugs, tobacco, profanity, sex, violence, gang membership or displaying obscene pictures in not permitted. **Pre-K - 4th** Artificial nails and hoop earrings.

Acceptable: TOPS AND BOTTOMS (e.g. Shirts & Pants)

- All styles of shirts must have collars.
- Styles: Button-style polo, oxford, dress shirts, turtlenecks, or knit-collared shirts.
- Colors: All solid colors
- School Shirts: Must be a polo, oxford dress shirt, or campus approved sweatshirt in the school color or have the school logo and be campus approved to be worn daily. Campus approved sweatshirts must be worn with a collared polo or oxford shirt underneath.
- Undershirts: Must be a solid color. All shirts must remain tucked at all times. Thermal shirts and Henley shirts are allowed.
- Logos: restricted to manufacturers/professional embroidered logos approximately the size of a student ID card/credit card (approximately 2 inches by 3 inches) or less.
- Shirts: May be short or long sleeved
- Tucking: Shirts must be fully tucked (grades PK-12)

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Clothing appearing to be pajamas or lounge wear.
- Overly tight or revealing cleavage (see through or low cut)
- Shirts with any embellishments, glitter, sparkle, etc.

Acceptable: HAIR

- Hairstyles must be neat and clean appearing.
- Subtle shades of natural or ethnically-acceptable hair colors and/or highlights.

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Combs or picks worn in the hair.
- Unnatural hair colors including primary colors, intermediate colors, and /or metallic colors.

Acceptable: SOCKS/HOSIERY/LEGGINGS

- Socks (ankle, mid-calf, and knee), hosiery, leggings, and tights. When hosiery, leggings and tights are part of the attire they must be worn under skirts or dresses.

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Leg warmers.

Acceptable: BELTS

- Colors: solids only-black, brown, navy, or white.
- Belts are required if clothing (pants, skirts, etc.) do not stay at the waist without it.
- Buckles should be approximately the size of a student ID card/credit card (approximately 2 inches by 3 inches), no larger.

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Patterns, designs, or ornaments buckles.

Acceptable: OUTERWEAR

- All outerwear must be worn over standardized dress and must fit appropriately (not oversized).
- Sweaters, sweater vests, and light weight jackets (fleece, windbreakers, etc.) are allowed as a layer over an acceptable style of top (see Tops section). They must be primarily one of the approved colors, but it might have accents of the other approved colors to be worn while in the building. They do not have to be tucked but must be worn over a tucked shirt and be appropriately sized in shoulders, arms, and length.

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Full-length jackets/coats such as those commonly referred to as "trench" coats or "dusters".
- Logos.

Notes

- Outside jackets and coats (i.e. starter and bulky jackets and coats) are considered cold weather apparel and should not be worn in the classroom.
- All outerwear must be worn over standardized dress and must fit appropriately (not oversized).
 - EISD letter jackets and school organizations sweaters or jackets are acceptable, regardless of the color of the item.
 - Outerwear does not have to adhere to approved shirts colors since it will not be worn inside the school.
 - Outerwear is considered cold weather apparel only for coming to school, recess (at lower grades) and leaving school.

Acceptable: FOOTWEAR

- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times while on school property.
- Any style or color of tennis shoes (tie or slip on).
- Gray, brown, black or white leather-like shoes and boots.
- Shoes designed with shoestrings should have shoestrings and be appropriately tied.
- Velcro and straps should be fastened.
- Grades 9-12: Heels should be 3 inches or lower.

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Cleats, high or spiked heels, roller heels, flip flops, house shoes, moccasins, and slippers.
- Footwear without an enclosed toe and heel.
- Grades PK-8: No heels allowed.
- Military-style, Steel-toed boot and UGG-style boots.

Acceptable: BOTTOMS: Jumpers/Skirts/Skort

- Colors: Solids only- black, navy, or any solid shade of the color khaki.
- Jumpers must have an acceptable shirt/top under them at all times (e.g. knit-collared shirt, turtleneck, blouse, etc.)
- Pleated or flat front style.
- Corduroy material is allowed.
- Polo/Tennis dresses (polo shirt style dress) in approved bottoms color (black, navy, or the color khaki).
- Polo/Tennis dresses, Jumpers, Skirts and Skorts when worn with leggings must be the appropriate length.
- Length:
Grades PK-4: hem of the jumpers/skirts/skort must not be more than 3 inches above the knee.
Grades 5-12: hem of the jumpers/skirts/ skorts must touch the kneecap or below.

Unacceptable (Not Allowed):

- Denim material of any color is prohibited (e.g. black, blue or the color khaki).
- Skinny style, overly tight or revealing (see through or low cut).
- Leather, suede, spandex, nylon, vinyl or stretch-type materials.
- Clothing appearing to be pajamas or lounge wear.

Acceptable: BOTTOMS: Pants/Shorts/Capris

- Pants/Shorts/Capris must be worn at the waist and properly hemmed/cuffed.
- Colors: solids only-black, the color khaki, (any shade), or navy.
- Pleated or flat front style (chino, cotton twill, etc.; most fabrics other than denim).
- Length:
Grades PK-4: hem of the pants/shorts/capris must not be more than 3 inches above the knee.
Grades 5-12: hem of the pants/shorts/capris must touch the kneecap or below.

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Sagging
- Oversized pants and pant legs.
- Skinny style, overly tight or revealing (holes).
- Leather, suede, spandex, nylon, vinyl or stretch- type material.
- Clothing appearing to be pajamas or lounge wear.
- Clothing which is torn or ragged.
- Rolled up pant legs.
- Jeggings.

Acceptable: HEAD COVERINGS

- None, except for special occasions approved by the principal. Exceptions and opt-out provisions will be considered for religions or medical reasons.

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Head coverings are not permitted and cannot be visible on campus, in the school building, or in the waiting areas on campus. Head coverings include, but are not limited to sweatbands, caps, hats, bandanas and skull caps.

Acceptable: OTHER ITEMS

- Girls' accessories such as bows, barrettes, headbands, etc. are not required to follow the approved standardized student dress colors.
- Ties: Neck ties are authorized only for school designated events.
- Pre-K- 4: studs only, 5th - 6th: Hoop earrings must not be larger than the size of a nickel (coin).

Unacceptable (Not Allowed)

- Arm socks
- Chains (such as those connected to clothing, wallets, etc.) large medallions, teeth grills, and articles with spikes including, but not limited to, dog collars.
- Excessive earrings and excessive gauging (holes in the ears).
- Jewelry referring to alcohol and other drugs, tobacco, profanity, sex, violence, gang membership, or displaying obscene pictures is not permitted.
- No designs are allowed in eyebrows.
- Scarves.
- Sunglasses and extreme styles of contact lenses during school hours.
- Visible body piercing except for the ears.
- Visible excessive tattoos that distract or take away from the academic climate.
- PK-4: Artificial nails and hoop earrings.

Notes

- Cosmetics (make-up, hair spray, colored lip product, cologne/perfume, scented body lotions, etc.) and jewelry should be worn in moderation or not at all.
- **PK-4:** Cosmetics or colognes/perfumes must not be brought to school.
